



- This unique design allows our spiral to start and stop without a jerking motion, making it perfect for top-heavy products such as boxes and bottles.
- The low-tension design also accommodates a wide variety of product weights and rates.
- Our spiral conveyor has many configuration options: washdown or non-washdown, incline or decline, single lane or dual lane, infeed/discharge orientation of 90°, 180°, 270° or 360°.
